- Ph.D in Music (or related faculty with a concentration in Music)
- Associate or Licentiate diploma from a Music Conservatory recognized by ORMTA
- Performer's Diploma

2. PROOF OF PEDAGOGY

Must include at least one of the following:

- Pedagogy courses from a university or recognized conservatory of music
- · Professional development workshops, conferences, webinars etc.

3. TEACHING EXPERIENCE*

Must include the following:

A) minimum honours results from six different students, representing at least three different grade levels of examinations

OR

B) any of the following to a total of six for each teaching subject:

- student results in recognized competitions and/or music festivals
- student acceptance into advanced programs of study
- proof of student receiving prestigious scholarships or awards
- student participation in concerts and master classes
- letter of recommendation from School Principal/Director
- · Press coverage highlighting student achievements

*Those with a DMA or PhD are exempt from providing teaching experience for their principle instrument.
